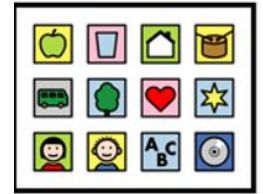




“Augmentative and alternative communication“ (AAC) at Mathilde-Eller-school
